

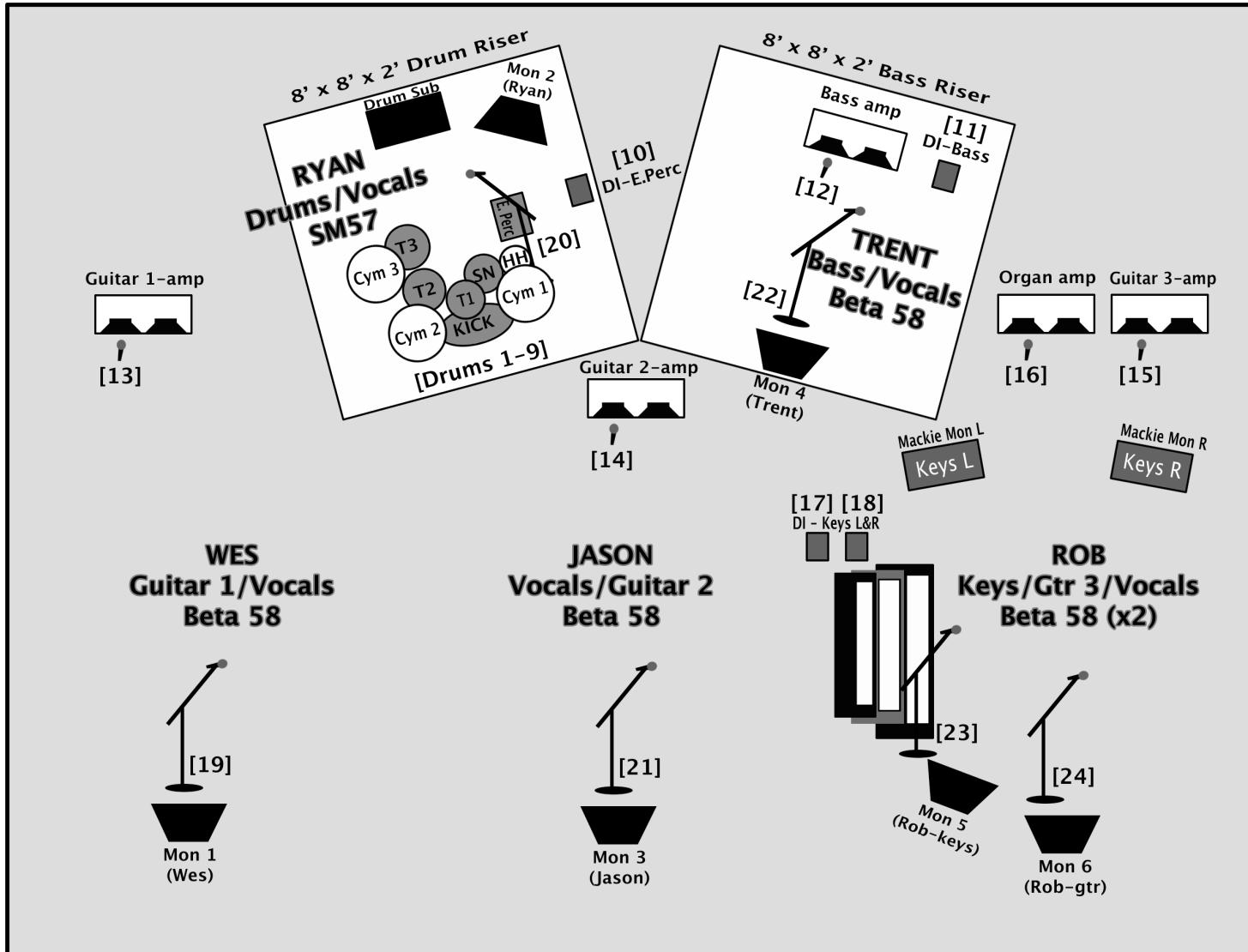

AUDIENCE

••NOTE: Band brings their own vocal microphones••

NOTES for VOCALS:

- ALL vox sing LEAD & should be balanced for 5-part harmonies
- Vocal effects are: (1) slightly-detuned, DOUBLING delay effect;
- (2) SLAP-DELAY set to approx. 220 ms; and (3) small amount of Medium Plate
- Monitor mixes should be mostly dry (a touch of FX is OK)

GENERAL NOTES:

- **AM/FM** plays all 70s FM Classic Rock and AM Pop, so the mix should be balanced and even regarding the bass, midrange and treble frequencies, with particular attention to balancing all the instruments equally to the ear.
- The Keyboardist also plays Guitar, often playing both within the same song.
- Drums should be fairly dry, with a small amount of Drum Plate.
